5. THE ARCHDIOCESE OF AGRA A HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

Agra Archdiocese consists of the following districts in Uttar Pradesh: Agra, Aligarh, Auriaya, Budaun, Bulandshahr, Etah, Etawah, Farrukhabad, Firozabad, Gautam Buddha Nagar, Hathras, Kannauj, Kanshiram Nagar, Mainpuri, Mathura and in Rajasthan, Bharatpur and Dholpur (17 Civil Districts).

Emperor Akbar wishing to have some learned Christian priests in his Court, invited the Jesuits from their college at Goa. The first 'Moghul Mission' was thus formed by Blessed Rudolf Aquaviva (later a martyr at Goa), Antony Monserrate and Francis Henriques, who arrived at the Moghul Court, then at Fatehpur Sikri in 1580. A second and then a third mission followed. Jesuits enjoyed the patronage of Akbar and his son Jahangir, but under Shah Jehan and Aurangzeb this disappeared. Though there was no Christian congregation of importance in Mughal India, there were a number of individuals who wielded considerable influence in the Court and elsewhere.

When in 1773 the Jesuits were suppressed, two Carmelite Fathers from Bombay succeeded them in Agra, who in turn, were replaced by the Capuchins after a very short while. By a decree of the Sacred Congregation, dated May 17th, 1784, the Vicariate-Apostolic of the Great Moghal was constituted. The history of the Agra Mission under the Capuchins is linked with their mission in Tibet. Early in 1708, four Capuchins starting from Kathmandu reached Lhasa after two months. More Capuchins followed them and took up their residence at Lhasa until April 20, 1745 when, owing to relentless persecution by the Tibetan Priesthood they had to leave Tibet and return to Nepal. Thus the Capuchin Mission in Lhasa came to an end. But the Mission continued its existence in Nepal until 1768.

The whole chain of Capuchin stations embracing the greater part of North India from Chandernagore to Lhasa, from Sind to Bengal, from the Himalayas to Narmada river, now the dioceses of Ajmer-Jaipur, Allahabad, Indore, Jhansi, Lahore, Lucknow, Meerut, Patna, Varanasi, Delhi, Jalandhar, Simla-Chandigarh, Bijnor and Jammu & Kashmir (formerly Rawalpindi) all came to be known as the Tibet Hindustan Mission. The Cathedrals at Agra, Ajmer, Allahabad, Delhi, Lahore (before the new one), Madras, Patna and Simla are symbols and monuments of the untiring zeal of the Capuchins for the extension of the faith and the progress of the Catholic Church in India.

The Prefecture Apostolic of Tibet -Hindustan was in 1820 constituted into the Vicariate Apostolic of Agra with Msgr. Maria Zenobia Benucci, OFM Cap as its first Vicar Apostolic, who was succeeded by Msgrs. Anthony Pezzoni and Anthony Borghi.

In 1845, the Agra Mission was divided into two separate vicariates: Agra and Patna. In 1846 the Kingdom of Tibet was entrusted to the Society of the Foreign Missions. In 1861 the districts of Allahabad, Oudh, Kanpur, Bundelkhand, Sagar and Bhopal were added to the Patna Vicariate, and in 1880 the districts of Kumaon and Almorah. In the same year, the Vicariate Apostolic of the Punjab was erected and separated from Agra. Finally in 1886 when the Catholic Hierarchy of India was established, the Vicariate Apostolic of Agra became a Metropolitan See from which the Prefecture Apostolic of Rajputana sprung in 1913, and in 1956, the nine northern districts were formed into the Diocese of Meerut.

Thus the Archdiocese of Agra is rightly called the Mother Diocese of all the Dioceses of North India.

6. IMPORTANT MONUMENTS

6.1. AKBAR'S CHURCH (The Church of Pieta)

Akbar's Church built in 1598 was the first Catholic Church of Agra and it was the Cathedral of Agra till 1848. The Church was built by the Jesuit Fathers under Akbar's order. It was a gift from the Mughal Emperor Akbar. In this Church the Mughal Emperors came to pray, especially Jahangir. Emperor Jahangir finding the Church built by his father, Akbar too small, donated a large sum of money for a larger and more beautiful Church to be built.

Two eminent Catholics, Khwaja Martins and Mirza Sikandar Junior contributed generously towards the extension of this Church.

In 1632 Emperor Shah Jahan declared war on the Portuguese. He defeated them in 1634. He brought over 4000 prisoners to Agra, all Christians. They underwent persecution and so did the Jesuit Fathers. In 1635 Shah Jahan released the Jesuit Fathers on condition that they pulled down their Church. This was done. However in 1636 the Emperor allowed the Fathers to rebuild the Church with the material of the ruined Church. On September 8, 1636 the reconstruction was completed and celebration of Holy Mass was resumed thereafter. It underwent great changes during the course of the next two centuries.

In 1758 the Persian Invasion under Ahmed Shah Abdali shattered the Mughal supremacy. During the siege of Agra, the Church was ransacked by the Persian soldiers.

In 1769 Walter Reinhardt then Commander of Agra Fort helped Father Wendel S.J. to rebuild the Church and make an extension. In 1835 Bishop Pezzoni with the generous aid from Sir John Baptist Filose extended the Church westward.

This Church has witnessed many a historical event. In 1610, three Royal Princes, nephews of the Emperor Jahangir, were baptized by Rev. Fr. Corsi, S.J. and Fr. Xavier S.J. It was here, the Begum Johana Sumroo, the Begum of Sardhana, was baptized. It was in this Cathedral the Religious of Jesus and Mary from France were formally received by Bishop Borghi in 1842. It was the proud privilege of Bishop Borghi to consecrate in this historic Church Msgr. Carli, Bishop of Almira in 1843 and the Servant of God Bishop Anastasius Hartmann, Vicar Apostolic of Patna in 1846. The Church has been refurbished and renamed '**The Church of Pieta**' by a decree from the Archbishop Albert D'Souza on September 17, 2013 during the Holy Eucharistic Celebration by the Most Rev. Vincent Concessao. Eucharistic Adoration is held daily from 11 a.m. to 5.30 p.m., concluding with the Holy Mass.

6.2. THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CEMETERY (MARTYRS' CEMETERY)

In 1604 Akbar gave a written order under his royal seal to build in Agra the Church known up to the present day as Akbar's Church. One of those Firmans states that in the fourth year of his reign Emperor Jahangir granted to the Agra Fathers 12 bighas of land (for the use of a cemetery) and a garden, free from all taxes. This cemetery is situated near the Civil Courts, on the road to Dayal Bagh. It is an enclosed garden with a big gate facing south. Its walls built of ancient small bricks are very high. It is still in use.

The history of this cemetery is of great value. It has therefore been declared a protected monument and placed under the care of Government. Many bodies were very often brought from long distances to this cemetery even when there was a Christian cemetery available locally. Thus men like the English Diplomat Mildenhall who died in Ajmer in 1614, the Italian Jerome Veroneo, the supposed architect of the Taj who died at Lahore in 1640 and many others are buried here.

Khojah Martyrose a very wealthy and generous merchant is buried in the mortuary chapel he himself built in 1611. This chapel is also the tomb of Fr. Mark Anthony Santucci, a saintly Italian Priest from Lucca who came to India in 1668 and died in 1686. He was and after so many years still held in reverence, that the chapel where he is buried is also known as the **PADRE SANTO CHAPEL** and vows are made of flowers, incense, candles etc. offered at his grave by Christians and non-Christians alike, for favours received through his intercession.

The cemetery is also known as the "Martyrs' Cemetery" because Fr. Manuel Garcia and Fr. Manuel Danhaya buried there, died in prison for the faith, the former on March 23,1634 and the latter on August 2,1635. Also because, during the persecution of 1632 to 1635 by Shah Jahan, hundreds of Portuguese and Indian men, women and children perished in Agra for the faith. Shah Jahan declared war against the Portuguese on June 11, 1632 for political reasons. It resulted in the attack and capture of their settlement of Hooghly on the North-West mouth of the River Ganges. 4400 prisoners were taken and they were bodily marched in chains to Agra. The journey took nine months. They were accompanied by Fathers Antonio de Christo, Francisco of the Incarnation, Joas de Cruz, Manuel Garcia and Manuel Danhaya. A great number of them died in prison or through terrible hardships because they refused to become Muslims. Their bodies were carried in the silence of the night to this cemetery and confined to pits and unmarked graves.

1. CATHEDRAL OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION AGRA

The present stately Cathedral is dedicated to Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception. The construction work was begun in 1846 by Rt. Rev. Dr. Joseph Anthony Borghi, O.C., the Vicar- Apostolic of Tibet-Hindustan and was solemnly blessed by him on January 1, 1848. The architect of the Cathedral was Rev. Fr. Bonaventure, an Italian from Florence.

In 1857 the Church was extensively damaged during the First War of Independence. The magnificent High Altar which was donated by Messrs John & Co. was consecrated with great solemnity by the Most Rev. Dr. Gentili, O.C., in December 1899. The beauty of the Church was further enhanced by paving its floor with white and black marble slabs and replacing the six plaster altars at the side with marble ones. The Cathedral has been renovated under the directions of Archbishop Albert D'Souza and Fr. John Ferreira in 2013.

2. ST. PATRICK'S CHURCH AGRA CANTT.

The Church was built in the beginning of the 17th century. The present Church blessed in the year 1848 was meant for the Irish Regiment. When the British left, Fr. Percy Quitero was appointed Parish Priest in 1950; followed by Fr. Aloysius OFM Cap; Fr. Edmund OFM Cap; Fr. Jose Muttath, Fr. Sebastian Pantaladi, Fr. C. J. Anthony, Fr. John Ferreira, Fr. George Paul, Fr. Bhaskar Jesuraj, Fr. Simon Tuscano and Fr. Joe Vadakkekara.

St. Clare's School was opened in 1959 by the Clarist nuns from Mount Mary's Bandra, Mumbai. They closed down the school in 1970. In 1971 the school was taken over by the Archdiocese of Agra and Rev. Fr. Jose Muttath was appointed as the Principal. The new school building was dedicated as a memorial to Archbishop Dominic Athaide's Episcopal Silver Jubilee. The Air Force Station is also served from this parish.

3. ST. MARY'S CHURCH AGRA

St. Mary's Church came into existence in April 1923 as a gift from the well-known John family of Agra, in memory of Mrs. Mary John. They also donated the adjoining compound with a large bungalow in it for the maintenance of the Church and the chaplain.

The foundation stone of this Church was laid in April 1920 and on its completion, was blessed by Archbishop Raphael Bernachioni on April 5th, 1923 and was dedicated to Mary, Mother of Good Counsel. Thus, the Church came to fulfill the long felt need of the residents of the locality as they found the Cathedral and St. Patrick's Parish too far for their spiritual needs. Around 1968, at the request of the H.A.L. employees, the dedication was changed by Archbishop Dominic Athaide to Mary Mother of Good Health, after the Shrine of Our Lady of Velankani in Tamil Nadu.

The Religious of Jesus & Mary, seeing the need of the Catholics, established St. Anthony's School in the vicinity of the Church.

The compound adjoining the Church was handed over to the Missionaries of Charity by the Archbishop in 1961. In 1964 Shishu Bhavan, a home for the abandoned, crippled and differently abled children was opened. Prem Dan, a home for the aged and dying destitutes was opened in 1980.

On the way to Etah from Bastar Fr. Joe Vadakekkara happened to stop in a village called Achalpur. Talking to the people, he came to know that there are CNI Christians without any shepherded. He opened a non-formal school in a shed belonging to Mr. Mahipal who is a Christian. Sunday Mass was offered for the 8 Christian families regularly. FCC Sisters and their Novices from Etah visited the place and catechised the families to Catholicism and were given First Communion and Confirmation on Easter Sunday of the year 1999 by the Founder Fr. 9. ST. FIDELIS CHURCH ALIGARH

It was on 2nd August, 1961 the then Archbishop Dr. Dominic Athaide appointed Fr. Edmund OFM Cap to initiate the first Mission Station of the Archdiocese of Agra. He started the mission in Aligarh residing in a rented room in Abdullah Lodge and offering Sunday Mass in the spacious residence of the then Aligarh Station Master, Mr. Cabral, a Catholic from Allahabad. Meanwhile the Archbishop invited the FSMA Sisters of Mhow (M.P.), to open a convent and an English medium School in Aligarh. The Sisters camped in Chhatri Wali Kothi on rent, and later shifted to Khalil Manzil. The school was in another building in the premises of Abdullah Lodge on Marris Road, till it was in permanent soil in 1967. The second Priest in-charge of the Mission, also the first Diocesan Priest was Fr. Thomas Paramundayil (1964-1967). His ingenuity, wisdom and farsightedness gave a permanent campus to the Mission. With the arrival of Sisters of the Missionaries of Charity, the Mission became more lively. After staying in a rented house for a couple of years, the Sisters moved to their own house in Jamalpur in 1983. The Mission was blessed with its Church in 1986 by Fr. Jose Akkara, the then Priest in-charge. The founding of St. Fidelis School in 1992 by Fr. K. K. Thomas, brought enhancement to the Mission. From 1993, the Holy Family Congregation has been rendering their services. Later in 2001, Fr. Sebastian Pantaladi shifted the classes from 6 upward to the new site in Tala Nagari. Fr. Dennis D'Souza upgraded the School to Senior Secondary. In the year 2005, the Fatima Sisters came to assist in the field of education. The unique, alternative ministry, catering to the needs of street children, Savio Navjeevan Bal Bhavan was established on 31st August 2005 by Fr. Jose Akkara. In July 2010, the congested shelter in Ekta Nagar reached to a spacious house in Tala Nagari.

The Inter-religious dialogue, a unique endeavour to bring the people of different faiths together, was very dear to the heart

of the pioneer Archbishop of Agra, the Most Rev. Dr. Dominic Athaide. He started this movement in Aligarh in the year 1974 itself. 'Sadbhavana' - a Centre for Inter-religious Dialogue - was established in 2012 in this Mission and is headed by Fr. Varghese Kunnath.

12. ROSARY MISSION BASTAR

In 1992, Fr. Joe Vadakekkara, the priest-in-charge of Etah Mission, came across a Chapel of American Presbyterian Christians in Bastar without any shepherd. He further started non-formal schools in Bastar, Mohan Nagla, Dharampur and Achalpur villages in Budi Ganga Tarai area of Etah District. These families were received into Catholic faith in 1995 by Fr. Joe Vadakekkara. From 1995 onwards ACDSS extended its helping hand to expand the social work to many more villages. In due course of time the place has developed owing to the constant visit and catechesis by the Masih Vidyapeeth seminarians and FCC Sisters. In 2003 a house was bought and the Archbishop of Agra inaugurated the place and

administered the Sacrament of First Holy Communion and Confirmation to 85 parishioners of the place. The Mission Station was named Rosary Mission as the day of blessing and Confirmation was held on October 7th, the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. The first residential Priest In-charge was Fr. Joseph Rodrigues appointed in the year 2006. The Sisters of CFMSS opened a convent in 2010.

**16. CHRIST THE REDEEMER CATHOLIC CHURCH
BUDAUN**

On March 24, 1991 Archbishop Most Rev. Cecil DeSa officially invited the Vincentian Fathers to the Archdiocese and on November 10, 1991 a contract was signed between them and the Archdiocese. On February 2, 1992, Fr. Joseph Edattu, then the Provincial Superior, inaugurated the Vincentian Mission in a rented building at Budaun. Fr. Varghese Naikomparambil was the first Vincentian Priest at Budaun. In 1993, Fr. Thomas Emprayil took charge of the Mission and continued to work from a rented building till 2000. As the need of the mission was to promote literacy, a project was planned to open as many literacy centres as possible especially in interior villages with minimum investment. Neither was land bought nor buildings constructed, but literacy missions with the U.P. Board syllabus came up in spaces provided by Panchayat or villagers. Within a few years, 35 such Centers were functioning. In 2006, Fr. Benny Elemlakattu took charge of

the literacy programme and continues to this day. Today, there is one School up to Class X and three Schools up to Class VIII with a total strength of 1795 students with a nominal fee of Rs. 10/- to Rs. 50/-. In 1997 De Paul School was opened in the city itself. The FCC Sisters extended their services in the mission.

In the city of Budaun there was a British-built Church unused and neglected. From 1992 onwards Fr. Varghese and Fr. Thomas tried to get it for the Catholic community. Success came in 1999. A house was built in the one acre Church compound and the Fathers had the privilege of living in their 'own' house after eight years in rented buildings. The Church was renovated beautifully and re-consecrated as the Church of Christ the Redeemer by Archbishop Oswald Gracias. The Parish of Budaun consists of eight Catholic families.

31. NISHKALANKA MATA CHURCH JAITH

It was some time in 1943 that Brother Xavier Braganza on one of his mission tours to Sirsa, came across a man named

Mangu from Jaith. Mr. Mangu used to frequent Sirsa as he had a relation in that village through marriage. He was very inquisitive about Christianity and its teachings which ultimately led him to have several rounds of dialogues with the Brothers. A few days later, a group of leaders from that village led by Mr. Mangu met the Brothers at Mathura Cantt and expressed their willingness to be instructed in the Christian doctrine. The enthusiasm of the people touched the hearts of the Brothers. In December 1945, before the Feast of the Nativity, the first batch of 317 people was received into the Church.

Fr. Gyan Prakash, IMS located a plot of land in Jaith in 1962. Brother Hubert who was at that time in Chandu Ka Nagla helped to purchase three acres of land for the Church. On this very land today, stands the Church, Convent, School and Hostel. At the time of the Most. Rev. Dominic Athaide, Fr. Virender built the Nishkalanka Mata Church in 1968. In the same year at the request of the Archbishop, Assisi Sisters of Mary Immaculate came to help in the village ministry. The hospital was built in 1972 with the aid of Catholics of West Germany through the Indo German Social Service Society. The first resident priest of Jaith was Fr. Joseph D'Souza. Fr. Stephen K. and Fr. Mathew Kumblumoottil succeeded him respectively. Assisi Sisters of Mary Immaculate withdrew their Sisters from Jaith in 1983.

On July 26, 1988 Sisters of the Congregation of Jesus and Mary arrived in Jaith. Fr. Varghese started Nishkalanka Mata School on July 12, 1990. Fr. Joseph Dabre opened a boarding for poor boys in 1992. On February 3, 2000 the Most Rev. Vincent Concessao laid the foundation stone for Nishkalanka Mata Hostel. Fr. Eugene Lazarus started the work of the hostel which was continued and completed by Fr. Andrew and blessed by the Most Rev. Oswald Gracias on August 15, 2001. Fr. Sunny K. and Joseph Rodrigues followed by Fr. Andrew were Parish Priests.

40. SACRED HEART CHURCH MATHURA

Mathura is a large town on the banks of Yamuna. In prehistoric times it was the capital of a mighty Hindu monarchy in which Agra, Etmadpur and other places as far as the Chambal River were included. During the middle ages it fell into the hands of the Muslims, during whose rule many monuments of historical importance were destroyed.

Mathura is known as the birth place of Lord Krishna. On the banks of the River Yamuna there are many sacred temples and ashrams, held in great veneration by the Hindus who come on pilgrimages from all over India.

Christianity has coexisted with Hinduism in Mathura for four centuries. The first European to come to Mathura was a French priest, Fr. Tavernier in about 1650. Another Frenchman Bernier visited Mathura in 1750 to install the astronomical instruments of Raja Jai Singh.

In 1803, Mathura and Agra were conquered by the British

under General Lake. Before 1800, a small community of Catholics mainly Armenians and Goans lived in Mathura. Later Mathura became the headquarters of the British troops. The foundation stone of the Church dedicated to the Sacred Heart was laid in 1874. The Collector of Mathura, Mr. Grouse, supervised the construction of the Church and contributed generously towards its building. Being a keen admirer of Oriental arts he adopted a pure Oriental style. The Church is in ordinary Gothic style but the dome is Russian in character. This church was blessed by Msgr. Jacopi, Archbishop of Agra, in 1876 in the presence of many Hindu gentlemen besides the Catholics.

The Franciscan Brothers of Mt. Poincur started their missionary work in Mathura in 1936. In 1956 the school run by the Parish of the Sacred Heart Church was given over to the Congregation of Mother Mary of Jesus Immolated. In 1958 the Archbishop invited the Congregation of the Carmelite Sisters of Trivandrum to look after the school for the diocese. In 1960 the Indian Missionary Society Fathers of Varanasi came to work in the Mathura Mission. Due to their efforts many villages were strengthened by the programmes of social uplift. Unfortunately, they left the archdiocese after some years.

**41. ST. MARY'S CHURCH
NOIDA**

At the northern tip of the Archdiocese of Agra lies St. Mary's Church with its borders touching the ecclesiastical territories of Delhi and Meerut. Even in the initial days of its growth and development, Noida being an industrial city, attracted thousands of people because of the many job opportunities, residential amenities and clean pollution-free environment, apart from the proximity to the capital city of Delhi.

Among the early migrants were a few Catholics who longed for the services of a priest. When Fr. Augustine Kuriappally, the then Parish Priest of Trilokpuri Parish in Delhi offered his services, the seeds of St. Mary's Parish were sown in January 1983. Even though the Priests from Delhi took care of the pastoral needs of the few Catholics, Noida remained 'no one's child' without any clear indication as to which diocese it belonged to.

The adoption process however was initiated in early 1984 when Fr. Johnson Chiriyankandath, the then Parish Priest of Bulandshahar, of the Archdiocese of Agra, started visiting Noida and finally took charge of the new parish from Fr. Cyrillo Rodrigues of Trilokpuri, on August 23, 1986. Thus Noida, became part of Agra Archdiocese. The foundation stone of the present beautiful and majestic Church in Sector 34 was laid by the Most Rev. Cecil DeSa, the Archbishop of

Agra on August 15, 1991 and exactly after two years, the same was dedicated to Our Lady at a majestic ceremony on August 15, 1993.

The advent of TOR Fathers in January 1997 added a new dimension to the pastoral care of the faithful. Under the dynamic leadership of Fr. Mathew Kumblumoottil (1994-1999) who succeeded Fr. Johnson, the parish grew into a vibrant community. Fr. Joe Thykkattil, Fr. Ignatius Miranda, Fr. Mathew Thundiyil & Fr. John D'Cunha have served the parish with singular devotion.

43. HOLY FAMILY CHURCH TUNDLA

The Church of the Holy Family was built in 1856 chiefly to look after the spiritual needs of railway employees consisting of Europeans and Anglo-Indians. Until 1967 this Church was visited by a priest from Agra to conduct services on Sundays and feast days. In the course of time the work of the Church developed and extended its services to the nearby villages

and hundreds were baptized. Unfortunately these people became apostates. Fr. Pius, Fr. Peter Celestine, Fr. Clement and Fr. Francis Lobo worked in the parish up to 1970.

On June 28, 1970 Fr. K. C. Thomas was appointed resident priest. On July 3, 1972 he opened Christ the King English medium school in a rented building. Later in September 1972, Franciscan Sisters of St. Joseph from Madras arrived to lend a helping hand in the Parish.

In 1978, Christ the King School was shifted from the rented building to the place purchased by the Archdiocese on the Agra-Kanpur Highway. The school was upgraded to a High School in 1985.

A new plot of land was purchased in September 2007 to relocate the primary sections. On August 15, 2008, the construction of the first phase of Christ the King Primary School commenced. In July 2009, the K.G. sections, in July 2010 Classes I to III and the rest of primary section in 2012 were relocated in the new campus; also the school was raised to senior secondary school.

Frs. Thomas K. C., Jose Akkara, Paul Thannickal, George Paul, Mathew Kumblumoottil have rendered their valuable services to this mission.
